Tour 07

Tour 16

In-shore, Half Day Fishing (no A/C) on the Monkey Sea

\$ Starting at \$1125 + 13% tax

⌚ 5 hours

Note | Fishing is very popular and availability is usually limited. The price doesn't include a fishing license (\$20) nor tips to the crew (recommended 15%-20%).

When fishing in-shore you will be looking to catch Rooster fish and Red Snapper. The tour starts at around 7 am, and finishes at 12 pm. There is a captain and crew to help you with your rods and bait. The price includes the crew (without tips), bait, tackle, softdrinks, water and beer.

Tour 17

Inshore, Full Day Fishing (no A/C) Jackpot sport fishing

\$ Starting at \$1,600 + 13% tax

⌚ 5 hours or 9 hours

Note | Fishing is very popular and availability is usually limited. The price doesn't include a fishing license (\$20) nor tips to the crew (recommended 15%-20%).

When fishing in-shore you will be looking to catch Rooster fish and Red Snapper. If you elect the full day there are more species such as Sailfish, Marlin, Tuna, Mahi Mahi. The full day goes to a Fish Attracting Device (FAD) which is 18-40 miles off shore where the fish congregate.

Tour 18

Offshore, Full Day Fishing (with A/C) on the Double Nickel

\$ Starting at \$2,500 + 13% Tax

⌚ 9 hours+

Note | Fishing is very popular and availability is usually limited. The price doesn't include a fishing license (\$20) nor tips to the crew (recommended 15%-20%).

Offshore fishing is a long day, but with much more and bigger fish! The Double Nickel targets sailfish and marlin as well as trophy sized mahi mahi, and yellowfin tuna. They offer full day fishing charters or multi day Fish Attracting Device (FAD) trips for incredible numbers of pacific blue marlin.

Frequently Asked Questions

General Information

Q: Where are the tours located?

A: All activities take place in and around Manuel Antonio. Tours such as rafting or tubing go further into the mountains for a better experience, but all tours are located within 1 hour of the villas, and most include transport.

Q: Are guides included?

A: Yes, most of the tours include bilingual guides. Some experiences also feature specialized instructors (e.g., surfing, freediving, chocolate making).

Q: What is included in the tours?

A: Most tours include transportation, fruits and drinks, safety equipment, and entrance fees where applicable. Specific inclusions vary per activity.

Q: Are meals provided?

A: Several tours include lunch or dinner (e.g., Chocolate Farm Tour, Brisa Elegante Cruise, ATV Tours). Please check the activity details.

Q: How long are the tours?

A: Tours range from 2 hours (zip-lining, chocolate tour) to full-day experiences (waterfalls, rafting, ATV). Average duration is 3–6 hours.

Pricing & Booking

Q: What is the cost of the tours?

A: Prices vary depending on the activity, starting at \$50 per person and ranging up to private boat charters at \$2,200. All prices are subject to 13% VAT.

Q: Are there child rates?

A: Yes. Several tours offer reduced rates for children (e.g., Chocolate Farm Tour, ATV Tours, Brisa Elegante Cruise).

Q: Do I need to book in advance?

A: Advance booking is highly recommended to secure your preferred time and date, especially for private tours or peak seasons.

Preparation & Equipment

Q: What should I bring?

A: Essentials include suncream, towel, dry change of clothes, and appropriate shoes. Some tours may require insect repellent, hats, or water.

Q: Do I need to bring equipment?

A: No, all necessary equipment (kayaks, surfboards, life jackets, snorkeling gear, helmets, etc.) is provided.

Q: What if I don't want to participate in the activity but still want to join?

A: For certain activities like surf lessons, non-participants can enjoy the beach setup for a small additional fee.

Special Notes

Q: Are there any restrictions or closures?

A: Manuel Antonio National Park is closed on Tuesdays. Some tours (e.g., mangrove kayaking) depend on the tide schedule.

Q: Is it safe for beginners?

A: Yes, activities like surfing, freediving, rafting, and tubing have options suitable for all levels, including complete beginners.

Q: Are private tours available?

A: Yes, you can book private boat tours, private surfing classes, or other customized experiences upon request.
